(The alternative is: You pay the penalty for your sins - eternally in Hell.)

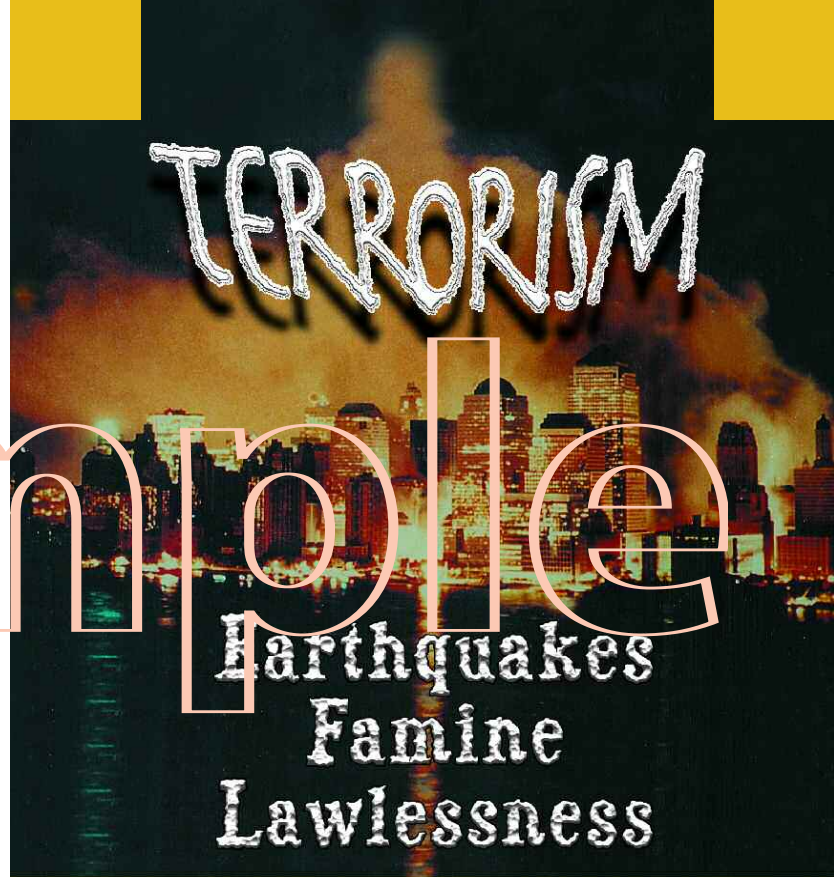
Not Sure?
